## HCAC Players of the Week

The following athletes were named players of the week in their respective sports for the week ending February 12, 2012.

### Men's Basketball – Brock Morrison, Anderson University

Anderson University senior forward Brock Morrison (Winchester, Ind./H.S.) notched a pair of double-doubles as the Ravens earned a 1-1 mark last week and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. The senior netted 19 points and hauled in a career-high 19 rebounds with four assists and three steals as the Ravens narrowly fell to Hanover 69-67 Wednesday evening. Morrison came back with 15 points, 14 rebounds, and four assists in AU's 79-65 win over Franklin Saturday. For the week, the senior averaged 17.0 points, 16.5 rebounds, and four assists. Anderson (13-10, 9-7 HCAC) can clinch a spot in the upcoming HCAC tournament with a win over Manchester or Mount St. Joseph this week.

### Women's Basketball – Alisa Dickerson, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology

Rose-Hulman's Alisa Dickerson (Elizabethtown, Ky./H.S.) led the Engineers to an upset win over No. 12 Franklin last week and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the third time. The senior narrowly missed a triple-double with 17 points, 14 rebounds, and eight assists in a 57-52 win over No. 12 Franklin College Wednesday evening. She followed that effort with 20 points, eight rebounds, five assists, and four blocks in a convincing 60-33 win over Defiance. For the week, Dickerson averaged 18.5 points, 11.0 rebounds, 6.5 assists, and 4.0 blocks per game, while becoming RHIT's career leader for assists with 322. Rose-Hulman (8-15, 6-10 HCAC) remains in contention to make next weekend's HCAC tournament and will face Earlham and Hanover this week.

### Men's Tennis – Henry Levin, Earlham College

Earlham College's Henry Levin (Dallas, Tex./Highland Park) won all four of his conference matches over the weekend as the Quakers went 2-0 in league play and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Men's Tennis Player of the Week. The junior earned a 6-1, 6-2 win at No. 1 singles and teamed with Anton Bartashvich for an 8-3 win at No. 1 doubles as the Quakers defeated RHIT 8-1 Saturday. In a 9-0 win over Franklin Sunday, Levin posted a 6-4, 6-0 victory at No. 1 singles and an 8-3 win at No. 1 doubles. Earlham (3-0, 2-0 HCAC) will return to the court on Wednesday at Denison.

## **Men's Track Athlete – Sutton Coleman, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology**

Rose-Hulman's Sutton Coleman (Lebanon, Va./H.S.) won two events at the Monmouth Indoor Invitational Saturday and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Men's Indoor Track Athlete of the Week for the third time. The senior set a school record to win the 200-meter dash in a conference-best time of 22.21 seconds and won the 60-meter hurdles in a conference-best time of 8.13 seconds.

## **Men's Field Athlete – Tom Postema, Defiance College**

Defiance College's Tom Postema (Defiance, Ohio/Tinora) won the weight throw at the All-Ohio Championships Saturday and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Men's Indoor Field Athlete of the Week for the fourth time. The junior won the weight throw with a toss of 59' 2.25" and placed second at the meet in the shot put with a mark of 53' 7.25". Postema received All-Ohio honors in both events and is currently ranked fifth in the nation in the shot put and ninth in the weight throw.

## **Women's Track Athlete – Distance Medley Relay Team, Bluffton University**

Bluffton University's distance medley relay team shattered the school record by 22 seconds at the All-Ohio Championships Saturday and has been named the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Women's Indoor Track Athletes of the Week. The team of Brandi Dominique, Kayla Mullenhour, Alison Janzen, and Maddie Moore finished sixth place at the meet in a school record time of 12:59.90. The time is also the fastest in the HCAC this season.
